





Applications Timetable - Admission Key Dates

From April 2022

Online Applications open.

25th June 2022

St Ambrose College Open Morning

This is an opportunity for you to look around the school, meet staff and pupils and ask any questions regarding the admissions process.

17th July 2022

Deadline for online applications. All applications will receive an acknowledgement.

If applicable, a completed Access Arrangements Request Form must be returned to St Ambrose College by this date.

Week Commencing 12th September 2022

You will receive information regarding the arrangements for the Entrance Examination.

Friday 23rd September 2022 - Entrance Examination Day

By no later than Friday 21st October 2022

Outcomes of the Entrance Exam will be sent to parents/carers of all candidates. A successful result in the examination is not a guarantee that a place at St Ambrose College will be offered. If more candidates pass than there are places available then the oversubscription criteria will be applied.

31st October 2022

The 'Common Preference Form' (CPF) must be returned to the home Local Authority. St Ambrose College must be specified as a preference.

1st March 2023

All candidates will be informed by their Home Authority which secondary school they have been allocated. Information regarding the induction process will be sent to parents upon confirmation of the acceptance of the offered place at St Ambrose College.

Oversubscription Criteria

If the number of applicants achieving the required standard for entry exceeds the Published Admissions Number, then the following over-subscription criteria will apply in the following order to decide which pupils to admit.

- 1. Baptised Roman Catholic boys who are designated 'looked after children' or 'previously looked after children'.
- 2. Baptised Roman Catholic Boys who are in receipt of Pupil Premium whose home postcode falls within a nominated Local Pastoral Area. Details are provided in the list of Nominated Local Pastoral Areas.
- 3. Baptised Roman Catholic boys who have a brother attending the school.
- 4. Baptised Roman Catholic boys whose home postcode falls within a nominated Local Pastoral Area.
- 5. Baptised Roman Catholic Boys who are in receipt of Pupil Premium.
- Other Baptised Roman Catholic boys.
- 7. Other Boys who are designated 'looked after children' or 'previously looked after children'.
- 8. Baptised Christian boys who have a brother attending the school.
- 9. Other boys who are in receipt of Pupil Premium.
- 10. Christian boys practising in other Christian denominations supported by a minister's reference confirming that they are a full and active member of the Church.
