


EPQ v Core Maths v 4 A-levels

Reduced offers from Universities

2 External exams in June; results on results day

Taught 4 lessons a fortnight

Log on project Q

Either a 5000-word report or an artefact

20 or more analysed sources

A PowerPoint presentation and script

EPQ- Artefact examples

- Write a film script
- Compose a piece of music for an event
- Create a piece of art work
- Design a sustainable house
- Create a budget Hawkeye
- Create a satellite



EPQ – Examples of essay/report titles

- How is blindness used as a symbol in literature?
- 'To what extent do external factors shape mixed race peoples identities in Contemporary British Society'
- The Great Recession, a detriment or triumph to the US socio-economy?
- To what extent is social media responsible for the increased prevalence of mental health problems in children and young adolescents?
- How effective is music therapy at helping those with Autism Spectrum Disorder?
- How early cold war / post world war 2 policy, and the Korean war led the cold war to becoming a proximity war between the West and Russia.
