Re: Hadrian's Wall Visit, 15 July 2019

The History and Latin departments are offering a trip for 20 pupils to visit the Roman Army Museum and the Vindolanda Centre in Hexham, which are situated in the central point of Hadrian's Wall.

Hadrian's Wall is a World Heritage Site and the focal points of our visit will be a visit to the Roman Army Museum and a guided tour of the Vindolanda site, including an archaeological talk. Between April and September there are live excavations taking place at the site, which the boys will be able to watch.

Our coach will leave school at 8.00 am on Monday 15th July and will return at approximately 6 pm. The cost of the trip is £38, including coach hire and museum entrance to both the Roman Army Museum and the Vindolanda Centre. The students should bring their own packed lunch and drinks for the day. Please note that due to individual dietary requirements we request that lunches and snacks **do not** contain or may contain nuts/peanuts.
