Re: Trip to CERN, Geneva, Switzerland on 28th-30th June 2019

To secure your son's place on the trip to Cern, a payment of £100 deposit is required in order to secure the necessary flights. The total cost of the trip will be £405.

The trip will include:

- EASYJET return flights from Manchester to Geneva International (hand luggage only)
- All connecting travel in Geneva (which will be by public transport)
- Accommodation (Half Board) at Hotel Central in Geneva's Old Quarter
- A guided tour of CERN and visits to CERN's exhibitions area
- A 45-minute cruise on Lake Geneva
- Trips to the History of Science Museum and time to explore Geneva's Waterfront and Old Quarter

In addition to the tour cost, your child will need spending money to cover all meals and sundry items. Please note that the school has the right to withdraw a place on the visit, if necessary, and this may result in you forfeiting any money already paid.

Please note that your son will require their own valid passport endorsed for travel within the EU, and a valid EHIC (which at present will still be valid). Please provide a photocopy of both the passport and EHIC card, in case of emergencies. Please visit the following website for more information on EHIC requirements.

The non-refundable deposit for the trip will be £100 and is due by 21 November at the latest. The second payment of £190 is due 31 January 2019, with the final payment of £115 is due on 15 March 2019. If there are any issues regarding these payment deadlines, please speak to me as soon as possible and we will do what we can to try and make alternative arrangements.
