

Keywords

Middle C – a key reference point on the piano; this is the C in the middle of the keyboard

Treble – above middle C.

Bass – below middle C

Staff – the lines on which notes are written

Walking fingers – the hand position we use to play the piano properly

Piano technique – the use of the fingers, wrist and arm to create the best sound possible

Chord – when we play two or notes at once to create a harmony
