Hook – a catchy tune used to grab the listener's attention

Four chord sequence – a highly common chord structure used in pop music

Verse chorus form – the most common structure of pop songs

Falsetto – a vocal technique used by men that is commonly used in pop

Chords I V VI IV – an extremely common chord sequence used in pop music

Popular music – a general term used to describe music that reaches the masses and can be made by anyone without formal musical training

Modulation – when a song moves into a newer key (often a higher one) to increase excitement
