Keywords

Riff – a repeating tune used to catch the listener's attention

Distortion – an effect used on guitar to make it sound gritty and rough

Power chords – when the middle note from the chord is taken away, creating a more aggressive sound

Backbeat – a drum beat where beats 2 and 4 are the strongest

Guitar solo – a section of the song where the lead guitarist shows off

Fortissimo – a dynamic marking that means 'very loud'. Commonly used in rock music to create an aggressive and forceful sound
