Key Date	Stage of Process	Additional Notes
Mid-April 2022	Online Applications open.	All applications will receive an automated acknowledgement.
25th June 2022	College Open Morning.	There will be an Open Day at the school on from 0930 to 1230 where you will be able to take a look around the school and where advice and help with the admissions procedure will be offered to prospective parents/carers. You do not need an appointment, just turn up on the morning.
15 th July 2022	Deadline for online applications.	
15 th July 2022	If applicable, a completed Access Arrangements request form together with supporting documentation must be returned to Saint Ambrose College by this date.	
Week Commencing 12 th September 2022	You will receive a pack detailing the specific arrangements for the Entrance Examination.	
Friday 23 rd September 2022	Entrance Examination Day	If your child is ill on the day of the exam, please do not bring him. Please email admissions@st-ambrosecollege.org.uk by 9.00am. You should obtain a doctor's note and send this to the College by no later than 30 th September.
By no later than Friday 21 st October	Outcomes of the Entrance Exam will be sent to parents/carers of all candidates.	A successful result in the examination is not a guarantee that a place at Saint Ambrose College will be offered. If more candidates pass than there are places available, then the oversubscription criteria will be applied.
31 st October 2022	The 'Common Application Form' (CAF) must be returned to the home Local Authority.	It is important that if you want your child to be considered for a place at Saint Ambrose College then it must be specified as a preference on the Common Application Form.
1 st March 2023	All candidates will be informed by their Home Authority which secondary school they have been allocated.	Information regarding the induction process will be sent to parents upon confirmation of the acceptance of the offered place at Saint Ambrose College.
