- Persuasive techniques
- Features of different types of fiction (e.g. Dystopian Fiction, Political Allegory, Refugee Fiction, etc.)
- Writer's methods/ literary devices (e.g. figurative language such as metaphors and similes, imagery, symbolism, etc.)
- You should practise your descriptive writing skills e.g. describing a particular setting, creating a specific atmosphere (e.g. eerie, joyful, calm, etc.)
- It is suggested that you spend some time reading fiction in preparation for the exam, as you will need to be able to understand written texts to a secure level and some ambitious vocabulary.

How to revise:

- Redraft previous assessments
- Watch YouTube videos on the topic
- Create flash cards (and include pictures/drawings and colours)
